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How will the results be used?

We will analyse the results to see if any action is required. We also publish the results and you will be able to see results for other surgeries to see how they compare.

Where will the results be published?

The results will be published on the NHS Choices website (www.nhs.uk).

We may also publish our results in the surgery.

Does this replace the existing compliments or complaints procedure, or other forms of feedback used by the practice?

No, you can still pass your compliments or complaints to us in the normal way, using our comments book or following our complaints procedure both of which are available at reception.
