

Important Notice to Patients & Visitors

There is an automated barrier entry and exit system to the front disabled parking and drop off area. This is to manage the volume of traffic using this route and to ensure it is only available for use by those it was intended to cater for since the volume of traffic on the forecourt has made it potentially unsafe for pedestrians including the elderly, frail, disabled and those with small children.

As originally intended, those disabled drivers with blue badges will still be able to park in the bays provided up to the maximum of 1 hr with their badge displayed should they wish to do so and providing a bay is available. Those wishing to drop off a disabled or elderly person with limited mobility will still be able to do so using the bay provided adjacent to the building but they will be unable to stop/park here and once dropped off they must exit from this area.

The drop off bay or disabled car parking bays are **not** for physically able people to drop off or collect prescriptions or other items. There is 30 minutes free parking in the car park adjacent to the library.

If you have a legitimate reason as detailed above to access this area once the barrier is in place you will be required to speak to the information desk personnel via an intercom at the barrier and access will be granted on this basis only. If you do not meet the criteria above please do not cause further congestion attempting to access the area as this will not be allowed.

Exit from the area in the front of the building will be by approaching the exit barrier which will rise.
